Small Diameter Pipe Raw Water Project and the Ione Water Treatment Plant Backwash Recycling Project drought grant funding approval

Requested Action:

Discussion and possible direction to the General Manager to execute the sponsor agreement with Upper Mokelumne River Watershed Authority for 2014 Drought Grant program with grant funds in the amount of \$5,755,504 of which \$5,126,560 is for the Small Diameter Pipe, Raw Water Project and the \$628,944 for the Ione Water Treatment Plant Backwash Recycling Project.

Background: These projects have been previously discussed with the Board and authorization to proceed. The grant funds will reimburse work dating back to January 2014. Upper Mokelumne River Watershed Authority has directed their Executive Officer to execute the drought grant agreement associated with these projects as well as the sponsor agreement with the Water Agency. This agreement is in the same format as previous grants received through proposition 84 via UMRWA.
