

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the Amador Water Agency, located at Amador Water Agency, 12800 Ridge Road, Sutter Creek, CA 95685, until 2:00 pm local time on Tuesday, July 23, 2019, or such later date as may be set by addendum, and then will be publicly opened and read for the construction of the CAWP Redwood Tanks Retrofit Project at Ridgeway Pines & Pine Acres, a public works project:

This Project consists of replacing 3 redwood tanks with 2 steel potable water tanks made of fire resistant material.

The contract documents for the Project, including the public works construction contract, instructions to bidders, bid forms, and plans and specifications, may be examined at the Agency office, with prior notice to the Agency's representative, located at 12800 Ridge Road, Sutter Creek, CA 95685. A copy of contract documents may be obtained at the Agency's office upon request, with a non-refundable payment of \$5 per DVD or free via download from the Agency FTP site. To request access to the Agency FTP site, email the Agency to request and submit the required plan holder request form. Bidders must comply with the Instructions to Bidders.

The Agency will hold a mandatory pre-bid conference at the Amador Water Agency office, 12800 Ridge Road, Sutter Creek, CA 95685, on Thursday, June 20, 2019 at 1:00 pm. Prospective bidders shall agree to and bring a signed copy of the Agency's Waiver and General Release to one of the pre-bid conferences. It is suggested that each prospective bidder review the bid documents and project site prior to the pre-bid conference of which they attend. Each prospective bidder shall be required to attend one of these two pre-bid conferences. Bids from any bidder not attending one of these two conferences will be rejected as non-responsive.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribed forms and accompanied by cash, a cashier's check, certified check or bid bond executed on the prescribed form payable to the Agency in an amount not less than 10 percent of the amount bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a payment bond and faithful performance bond each in the full amount of the Contract price, and insurance with certificates and endorsements of insurance, as provided in the Contract Documents. The required bonds must be provided only by a surety insurer who is admitted to do business by and in good standing with the California Department of Insurance.

Bidders are hereby notified that in accordance with Public Contract Code section 22300, securities may be substituted for any monies that the Agency may withhold pursuant to the terms of this Contract to ensure performance.

Bidders are advised that proof of six good faith efforts, DBE certification and posting solicitations for DBE proposals for a minimum of 30 calendar days in a local newspaper, before the bid opening date, is required.

The successful bidder must possess the following classification or type of contractor's license issued by the Contractors State License Board: Class A, California.

To be qualified to bid on this Project, bidders must be registered and qualified to perform public work with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant section 1725.5 of the Labor Code. All subcontractors listed in a qualified bidder's bid as performing any portion of the work also must be registered and qualified with the Department of Industrial Relations.

The attention of bidders is directed to the requirements and conditions of employment to be observed and prevailing wage rates to be paid to all workers employed under the Contract in accordance with Labor Code sections 1770 and following. Copies of the prevailing rate of per diem wages are on file at the Agency's office, and will be made available to any interested party on request. In accordance with Labor Code section 1771.4(a)(1), this project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

The Agency reserves the right to reject all bids. Any bid not conforming to the intent and purpose of the Contract Documents may be rejected. The Agency may extend the time to award the Contract.
