



## **Pioneer Water Rehabilitation Project – Phase 2**

To: Neighbors of the Pioneer Water Rehabilitation Pipeline Project

The Amador Water Agency (AWA) is planning on starting the Pioneer Water Rehabilitation Pipeline Phase 2 Project (Project) in July 2020. The Project is being funded almost entirely through a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

**Project Location:** The Project is located in the Pioneer area, approximately 12 miles northeast of the City of Jackson near State Route (SR) 88, and spans a distance of approximately 1.5 miles, beginning along Buckhorn Ridge Road near Deadwood Court and proceeding east towards the intersection of Buckhorn Ridge Road and Prospect Drive.

**Project Description:** AWA is constructing the pipeline in order to significantly increase the amount of water available at existing fire hydrants, install new high flow fire hydrants, provide a looped water system, and improve the distribution system reliability in the Buckhorn Ridge area of the water system. New construction of facilities includes installation of approximately 1.5 miles of a buried 12-inch potable water pipeline in the roadway and a replacement pump station on Elkhorn Court.

Construction is mostly in the existing paved road or shoulder along Buckhorn Ridge Road. The existing pavement or ground will be restored to equal or better than the current condition. The project will include trench excavation, piping, and paving. Construction is currently scheduled to begin around July 15, 2020 and is expected to be completed by December 2020.

There will be traffic control delays on lower Buckhorn Ridge Road to allow for construction, however upper Buckhorn Ridge Road will remain available as an alternate route.

Phase 3 of this project is currently scheduled for 2021, depending on funding. Phase 3 would complete the pipeline in Prospect Place, Oxbow Road, Deer Trail and Elkhorn Court. A phasing map is on the reverse side for reference.
