## GENERAL POLICY & DISCLAIMER

Information presented on this website is collected, maintained, and provided as a public service for the convenience of the user. Under no circumstances will the Agency be liable for any actions taken or omissions made from reliance on any information contained herein from whatever source nor will the Agency be liable for any other consequences from any such reliance. Please keep in mind that no use of or data transmission over the Internet or any wireless network can be guaranteed as secure. As a result, the Agency cannot guarantee the security of any information that you transmit using our website and you transmit any such information at your own risk.

## CONDITIONS OF USE

## **PRIVACY POLICY**

We will collect no personal information about you when you visit our website unless you choose to provide that information to us voluntarily. However, by using the Agency's website and providing personal information, you give your consent to the Agency's collection of your personal information as described herein. If you do not consent to the collection, use or disclosure of any personal data, please do not provide any personal information. We do not give, share, sell, or transfer any personal information to a third party, unless we are legally required to do so or it is necessary to provide requested services to a customer or visitor.

The Agency reserves the right to analyze user traffic patterns on our website from information that is automatically provided to us by your browser when you visit our site. This information includes the IP address of your computer or network, the date, time, and page you visited on our site, your browser and operating system, and the referring page (the last web page you visited before clicking on a link to our site). We use the aggregated information from all of our visitors to measure server performance and improve the content of our site.
